Some questions to consider as you are reading...

January 23 – Genesis 32-34

- How did Jacob address the Lord? (32:9-12) How do we address Him?
- Who did Jacob wrestle with? What did God change about Jacob? (32:24-30)
- In chapter 33, did the reunion between Jacob and Esau go as Esau feared? Why not?

January 24 – Genesis 35-37

- After the vengeance wrought by Simeon and Levi slew the men of Shalem (34), why is it that the people of the land did not harm them? (35:5)
- To whom did God repeat promises? What were they? (35:9-15)
- Why did Esau move to Mt. Seir? (36:1-8)
- How did Joseph's brothers and father react to his dream (37:5-11)?
- How did Joseph end up in Potipher's house (37)?

January 25 – Genesis 38-40

• How was Joseph able to resist the advances of Potipher's wife (39:7-9)?
