#### Introduction

- Lesson text: Col. 3:5-9
- 1. "In the beginning God..." (Gen. 1:1).
- 2. "Thou shalt have no other gods before me" (Ex. 20:3).
- 3. "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God" (Jn. 1:1-2).
- 4. In all ages of men God has always demanded that He be first and thus has always forbidden idolatry.
  - a. There is no God besides Him anyway (<u>Isa. 44:6</u>; cf. <u>Isa. 44:8</u>, <u>45:5</u>, <u>21</u>; <u>Hos. 13:4</u>).
  - b. The foolishness of idolatry (Ps. 115:1-8).
- 5. Idolatry defined.
  - a. eidololatria (G1495 noun) found four times in the New Testament (<u>1 Cor. 10:14</u>; <u>Gal. 5:20</u>; <u>Col. 3:5</u>; <u>1 Pt. 4:3</u>).
    - i. "the worship of idols" (Louw-Nida 540).
    - ii. An idol is a false god that may be represented in many ways e.g., image, statue, picture/painting, imagination, etc.
  - b. Another definition for idolatry is anything that we place before God (Mt. 6:33; cf. 1 Cor. 10:14-22).

# I. Why is Idolatry a Problem?

- 1. Idolatry is a problem because two evils are committed by it (Jer. 2:13).
  - a. Judah had forsaken the one, true, and living God for idols (Jer. 2:5-11).
  - b. Why would anyone do this?
    - i. No fear of God (<u>Jer. 2:19</u>; cf. <u>Ps. 36:1</u>).
    - ii. Ignorance (Ac. 17:22-23; cf. Pr. 1:7, 9:10).
    - iii. Lack of glorification of God and not thankful to Him (Rm. 1:20-25).
- 2. Idolatry is a problem because it is an abomination to God (<u>Jer. 2:7</u>; cf. <u>Dt. 7:25-26</u>).
- 3. Idolatry is a problem because it is vain (<u>Jer. 2:5</u>; cf. <u>Dt. 32:21</u>).
- 4. Idolatry is a problem because it deceives (Isa. 44:9-20).
- 5. Idolatry is a problem because it condemns the soul to hell (Gal. 5:19-21).
  - a. Idolatry can be cured (1 Cor. 6:9-11).

## II. Idols of Today

- 1. Pleasures.
  - a. Illicit sexual intercourse (Rm. 1:26-27).
  - b. Alcohol, smoking, vaping, other drug use, etc. (1 Th. 5:6-8).
  - c. Be careful with entertainment, sports, gaming, etc.
- 2. Possessions.
  - a. Life is not about material possessions (Lk. 12:15).
  - b. Covetousness, which is idolatry (Col. 3:5; Eph. 5:5).
  - c. Be careful with cellphones and the Internet.
- 3. Busyness.
  - a. Poor time management which results in being busy with everything that there is no time for God.
  - b. We are to redeem the time (Eph. 5:15-17).
- 4. Self.
  - a. Creature worship is still a problem today (Rm. 1:25).
- 5. False religions.
  - a. People have invented imaginary versions of God and thus made false religions.
  - b. We are to be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment (1 Cor. 1:10).
  - c. Christ only built one church (Mt. 16:18-19; Eph. 1:20-23, 4:4).

# III. How to Put Off Idolatry

- 1. Fear God and keep His commandments (Ecc. 12:13-14).
- 2. God must be our everything (Mt. 6:33, 22:37).
- 3. Be thankful in all things at all times (Eph. 5:20).
- 4. Glorify God (Eph. 3:21).
  - a. We glorify God by doing what He says (Jn. 17:4).

### Conclusion
