### Introduction

- <u>Lesson text</u>: <u>Col. 3:10-15</u>
- 1. In addition to compassion, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering, and forbearance, we have three more qualities to put on that make up the new man.

# I. Put on Forgiveness

- 1. The new man forgives those that need forgiveness (Col. 3:13).
  - a. forgiving (charizomai G5483 verb, present tense).
  - b. one another (heautou G1438 reflexive pronoun).
- 2. One cause for forgiveness that is given is "if any man have a quarrel against any" (Col. 3:13).
  - a. Translated as "if any man have a complaint against any" in the ASV.
  - b. quarrel (momphe G3437 noun).
  - c. Consider Mt. 5:23-24; Mk. 11:25-26.
  - d. Example of forgiveness (2 Cor. 2:1-10; cf. 1 Cor. 5).
- 3. We need forgiveness from God so we need to forgive others (Col. 3:13).
  - a. God forgives us through His Son when we obey His conditions (<u>1 Jn.</u>
    2:12).
    - i. We know that Jesus was willing to forgive (Lk. 23:34).
    - ii. His prayer was answered on Pentecost and every time a sinner obeys the gospel (Ac. 2:36-41).
  - b. How often should we forgive (Mt. 18:21-22)?
  - c. Why should we forgive (Mt. 18:23-35)?
  - d. Repentance is necessary to forgiveness (Lk. 17:3-4).

## II. Put on Love

- 1. Charity or love must be put on (Col. 3:14).
  - a. charity (ho G3588 definite article agape G26 noun) most often translated as "love" in the New Testament (86 of 116 times).
  - b. The pinnacle of all of these qualities is love hence the use of the words "above all" (cf. <u>1 Cor. 13:13</u>).

- 2. Why is love "above all?"
  - a. It is the bond of perfectness.
  - b. the bond (syndesmos G4886 noun).
  - c. of perfectness (ho G3588 definite article teleiotes G5047 noun).
  - d. Love is the great binder that brings the new man to completion.

### III. Put on Peace

- 1. The peace of God must be allowed to rule in our hearts (Col. 3:15).
  - a. peace (eirene G1515 noun).
  - b. rule (brabeuo G1018 verb, imperative).
  - c. Follow peace with all men as much as is possible (<u>Heb. 12:14; Rm. 12:18</u>).
- 2. Jesus Christ brought peace in His church.
  - a. He is the Prince of Peace (Isa. 9:6).
  - b. He brought the gospel of peace (Rm. 10:15; Eph. 6:15; Ac. 10:36).
    - i. We are called by the gospel (2 Th. 2:13-14).
  - c. The location of peace is in Christ's church (Eph. 2:11-22).
    - i. There is just one body therefore there is no peace with God anywhere else (cf. Eph. 3:21)!

### Conclusion

- 1. The new man is composed of essential qualities that reflect the beauty of our Creator.
  - a. We are to be conformed to the image of Christ (Rm. 8:29).
- 2. We all need forgiveness from God therefore we need to forgive others.
- 3. Love is the great binding quality that brings the new man to completion.
- 4. The peace of God must rule in our hearts as we remember the peace we have with God in His Son's church.
