#### Introduction

- Lesson text: Ps. 50:10-15
- 1. We all need reminders from time to time (cf. 2 Pt. 1:12ff).
  - a. Why? Our minds are bombarded with so much information on a daily basis.
  - b. Without reminders we are prone to forget some very important information.
- 2. Certain reminders should lead us to thanksgiving to the God of Heaven.

### I. Remember That the Earth Belongs to God

- 1. The Earth belongs to the LORD because He created it (Ps. 24:1-2; cf. Ps. 89:11).
  - a. Consider the creation record (Gen. 1).
    - i. God spoke the Universe into existence (Ps. 33:6).
    - ii. He preserves it with His Word (2 Pt. 3:5-7; cf. Col. 1:16-17).
  - b. As our Creator, we should be thankful for Him (Ps. 100:1-5).
    - i. God wants the sacrifice of praise, the fruit of our lips, in thanksgiving (Ps. 50:10-15; Heb. 13:15).
- 2. Since the Earth belongs to the LORD, He is sovereign over His creation (Ps. 67:4, 47:2; cf. Ps. 83:18, 97:9).
  - a. The fact God is King of all the Earth prompts songs of praise (Ps. 47:6-8).
- 3. Since the Earth belongs to God, He owns everything (1 Chr. 29:10-17).

# II. Remember That the Church Owes Her Origin and Existence to God

- 1. The church was in the mind of God from eternity (Eph. 3:9-11).
  - a. This means that the church precedes all other religious institutions in origin.
- 2. Christ only promised to build His church (Mt. 16:13-19).
  - a. Only one church was built (Eph. 1:20-23, 4:4).
  - b. Religious sectarianism is not God's plan (<u>1 Cor. 1:10</u>; cf. <u>1 Cor. 11:18-19</u>, <u>12:25</u>).
- 3. It required the blood of Christ to purchase the church (Ac. 20:28; cf. 1 Cor. 6:20).

- a. Therefore, Christ owns the church hence the name "church of Christ" or the church which belongs to Christ (Rm. 16:16).
- b. The church is not of manmade origin.
- 4. The church was established on Earth on the Day of Pentecost following Christ's death (Ac. 2).
  - a. This was in accordance with what Jesus Himself said would happen (Mk. 9:1; Ac. 1:4-8).
  - b. The church is the location of the saved (<u>Ac. 2:47</u>; cf. <u>Eph. 1:3-14</u>, <u>2:1-22</u>, <u>5:23</u>).

## III. Remember Our Birthday

- 1. To become a Christian one must be born again (Jn. 3:1-8).
  - a. A Christian has two birthdays with the spiritual birthday being the most significant.
  - b. Being born again takes place at baptism (Tt. 3:5; 1 Cor. 12:13; Eph. 5:26).
  - c. Baptism is the means by which one puts on Christ and gets into Christ (Gal. 3:26-27).
  - d. Upon being born again, one becomes a child of God (Jn. 1:12-13).
- 2. It took the crucifixion of Christ for us to be redeemed (1 Pt. 1:18-21).
  - a. This makes the church of equal value as the blood of Christ (Ac. 20:28)!
  - b. We need His blood to wash us from our sins (Rev. 1:5).
  - c. That blood is contacted in baptism (Ac. 22:16).
- 3. God gave us a weekly reminder for what He did for us (1 Cor. 11:23-26).
  - a. Let us remember this great sacrifice and be thankful!
